

# Fees, scholarships and bursaries

Citipointe's Schedule of Fees for 2024 is designed to be an all-inclusive tuition fee and will cover all curriculum-related activities. The tuition fees quoted can be paid annually, by term or by smaller, more frequent payment via Edstart. [edstart.com.au/citipointe](https://edstart.com.au/citipointe)

The tuition fee will be inclusive of:

- day excursions
- weekly sport
- year level camps (with the exception of tourist or elective activities)
- secondary curriculum camps
- government examination fees
- academic competition fees

Items that are outside the all-inclusive fee and attract an additional fee are:

- certain co-curricular and extra-curricular sports and activities
- tutoring through Citipointe Christian College Academy and with the College's Academy of the Arts
- international travel under the International Student > A
- musical instrument hire
- sessions with the Independent Study Centre
